
World Human Rights Day

World Human Rights Day is observed every year on 10 December. On this day the United Nations General Assembly adopted, in 1948, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR). The UDHR is a milestone document, which proclaims the inalienable rights that everyone is entitled to as a human being - regardless of race, colour, religion, sex, language, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth or other status. This year's Human Rights Day theme relates to 'Equality' and Article 1 of the UDHR — "All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights."

The principles of equality and non-discrimination are at the heart of human rights. Equality is aligned with the 2030 Agenda and with the UN approach set out in the document 'Shared Framework on Leaving No One Behind: Equality and Non-Discrimination at the Heart of Sustainable Development'.

This prestigious campaign run by N.C. Jindal Public School, aimed to mobilize the world's youth to value every individual's rights. The young Jindalites also became a part of this exalted global movement that promotes addressing and finding solutions for deep-rooted forms of discrimination that have affected the most vulnerable people in societies, including women and girls, indigenous people, people of African descent, LGBTI people, migrants and people with disabilities, among others.

As part of the campaign, teachers displayed a video based on the human rights in their classes which helped bring awareness among the Jindalites. They also took a pledge to stand up whenever anyone's rights are not respected. The campaign proved to be a great success as a wave of enthusiasm could be seen among the young Jindalites as they viewed the video and took the pledge.








